Key	Patient safety above all else
Principles	<ul> <li>Protect patients from harm</li> <li>Fair and open procedures</li> <li>Opportunities for improvement</li> <li>Standards / criteria for measurement of improvement / successful remediation</li> </ul>
Mandatory reporting events	<ul> <li>Impairment (physical or mental impairment detrimentally affects capacity to practise)</li> <li>Intoxication while practising (usual meaning)</li> <li>Significant departure from accepted professional standards (practice + behaviour)</li> <li>Sexual misconduct (even consensual activity is misconduct)</li> <li>* Must have a reasonable belief of substantial risk of harm to public</li> </ul>
Management	<ul> <li>Gather information</li> <li>Involve senior / trusted clinician</li> <li>Seek internal support</li> <li>Maintain thorough documentation</li> <li>Advice from HOD / MD</li> <li>Referral to ANZCA</li> <li>Referral to AHPRA</li> </ul> *Starting step will depend on severity + level of risk
